- provide adequate resources to ensure the health and safety of staff, dogs and those around us;
- provide appropriate supervision to ensure training & trialing is carried out in a safe and healthy manner;
- regularly review all health and safety systems to maintain their effectiveness.

The Board of management of AUSTRALIAN UNITED SPORTDOG CLUBS INC shall ensure that regulatory requirements pertaining to safety matters under the H&S Act are complied with, communicated with members and that appropriate training is provided as required.
